The Engineering Institute of Canada will celebrate its 125th anniversary this year with two awards events. The first will take place at the Westin Hotel in Ottawa on Saturday evening, 25 February 2012. The second will be a joint event with the Canadian Society for Civil Engineering who is also celebrating the same anniversary. It will take place at the Shaw Convention Center in Edmonton Alberta on June 7 2012.

At the Ottawa event, in addition to the induction of eleven Fellows and the award of two senior medals, the K Y Lo a Julian C. Smith medal, five outstanding engineering achievements in Canada will be recognized by the induction of the four companies currently responsible for them into the institute as Honorary Members. The engineering achievements are: TRIUMF; Confederation Bridge; The CN Tower; RADARSAT I & II and CANADARM.

At the Edmonton event ten Fellows will be inducted and three senior medals, a Julian C. Smith, the K Y Lo and the John B. Stirling medal will be awarded in a ceremony that will include CSCE awards.

EIC President Tony Bennett will preside at the Ottawa Awards Banquet and Jean Zu, President-elect will preside on the EIC's behalf in Edmonton.
