### **Procedures and Criteria for CSSE Fellowship Award Nominations**

1. CSSE has established a Fellowship Awards Steering Committee, comprised of a Chairman plus four CSSE Directors.
2. CSSE Directors can receive suggestions from any other member of the CSSE, accompanied with a CV or Bio plus two supporting letters from respected fellow engineers or peers. As many of those nominated for the awards are presently retired, a note from the nominator outlining a short bio of the nominee with a resumé highlighting his/her past engineering experiences should suffice in many cases.
3. FCSSE Committee make up a list of suggested recipients from submissions and send to CSSE Chairman. CSSE suggests that about eight names be worked on by the Fellowship Awards Steering Committee.
4. CSSE Chairman and Steering Committee will vet the suggested names and advise Directors of those that should be considered.
5. The FCSSE Committee will determine the number of engineers to be chosen whose Fellowship Award Certificates will be presented at the CSSE AGM Dinner. The number of Fellowship Awards recipients should preferably include a majority who will be present and a lesser number in absentia.
6. All CSSE Directors are to keep their choices secret from the selected persons until the final selection has been made.
7. Certain suggested names will be put forward to the following year's Committee and all non-deserving names will be dropped. Those names being held for the following year must have CV and/or Bio and supporting letters both updated and upgraded for next year's Committee's selection.
8. CSSE will expect that recipients pay for their own expenses in coming to the CSSE AGM to accept the award. CSSE can not reimburse expenses, only the meal cost. CSSE also would like to be assured that the nominee will travel to the AGM as CSSE does not like to make too many absentee awards.
9. CSSE Directors should consider only those that have given much to the Engineering profession and the various Engineering Societies for the betterment of the Engineering Profession as well as their own accomplishments in the Engineering field.

Those being nominated should at least be a members of the CSSE or be eligible to become a member before he or she is nominated. The CSSE Chair to write the soon-to-be nominee inviting them to become a membe
